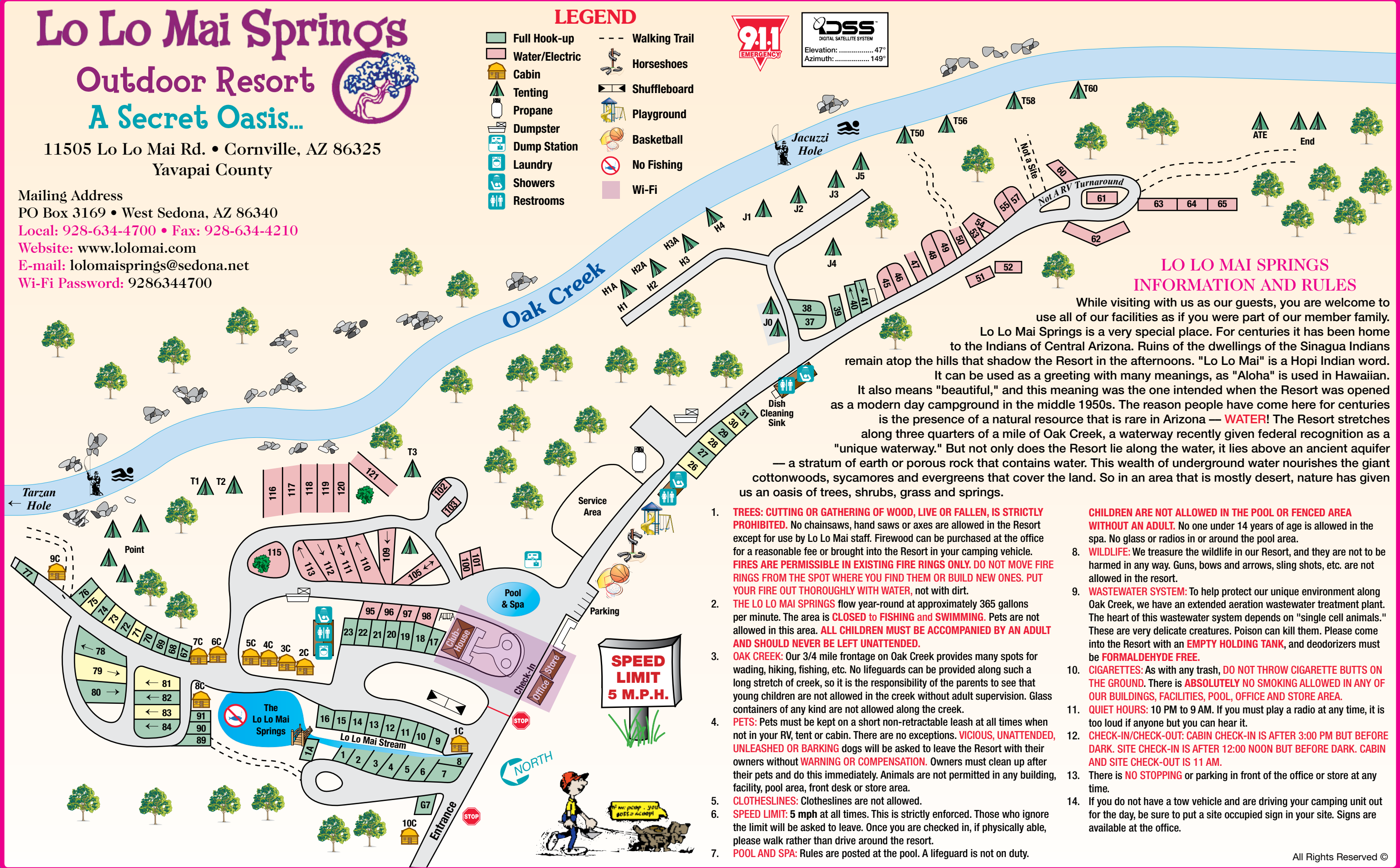

LO LO MAI SPRINGS INFORMATION AND RULES

While visiting with us as our guests, you are welcome to use all of our facilities as if you were part of our member family. Lo Lo Mai Springs is a very special place. For centuries it has been home to the Indians of Central Arizona. Ruins of the dwellings of the Sinagua Indians remain atop the hills that shadow the Resort in the afternoons. "Lo Lo Mai" is a Hopi Indian word. It can be used as a greeting with many meanings, as "Aloha" is used in Hawaiian. It also means "beautiful," and this meaning was the one intended when the Resort was opened as a modern day campground in the middle 1950s. The reason people have come here for centuries is the presence of a natural resource that is rare in Arizona — **WATER!** The Resort stretches along three quarters of a mile of Oak Creek, a waterway recently given federal recognition as a "unique waterway." But not only does the Resort lie along the water, it lies above an ancient aquifer — a stratum of earth or porous rock that contains water. This wealth of underground water nourishes the giant cottonwoods, sycamores and evergreens that cover the land. So in an area that is mostly desert, nature has given us an oasis of trees, shrubs, grass and springs.

- TREES: CUTTING OR GATHERING OF WOOD, LIVE OR FALLEN, IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.** No chainsaws, hand saws or axes are allowed in the Resort except for use by Lo Lo Mai staff. Firewood can be purchased at the office for a reasonable fee or brought into the Resort in your camping vehicle. **FIRES ARE PERMISSIBLE IN EXISTING FIRE RINGS ONLY. DO NOT MOVE FIRE RINGS FROM THE SPOT WHERE YOU FIND THEM OR BUILD NEW ONES. PUT YOUR FIRE OUT THOROUGHLY WITH WATER, not with dirt.**
- THE LO LO MAI SPRINGS** flow year-round at approximately 365 gallons per minute. The area is **CLOSED to FISHING and SWIMMING.** Pets are not allowed in this area. **ALL CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AND SHOULD NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED.**
- OAK CREEK:** Our 3/4 mile frontage on Oak Creek provides many spots for wading, hiking, fishing, etc. No lifeguards can be provided along such a long stretch of creek, so it is the responsibility of the parents to see that young children are not allowed in the creek without adult supervision. Glass containers of any kind are not allowed along the creek.
- PETS:** Pets must be kept on a short non-retractable leash at all times when not in your RV, tent or cabin. There are no exceptions. **VICIOUS, UNATTENDED, UNLEASHED OR BARKING** dogs will be asked to leave the Resort with their owners without **WARNING OR COMPENSATION.** Owners must clean up after their pets and do this immediately. Animals are not permitted in any building, facility, pool area, front desk or store area.
- CLOTHESLINES:** Clotheslines are not allowed.
- SPEED LIMIT: 5 mph** at all times. This is strictly enforced. Those who ignore the limit will be asked to leave. Once you are checked in, if physically able, please walk rather than drive around the resort.
- POOL AND SPA:** Rules are posted at the pool. A lifeguard is not on duty.

- CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR FENCED AREA WITHOUT AN ADULT.** No one under 14 years of age is allowed in the spa. No glass or radios in or around the pool area.
- WILDLIFE:** We treasure the wildlife in our Resort, and they are not to be harmed in any way. Guns, bows and arrows, sling shots, etc. are not allowed in the resort.
- WASTEWATER SYSTEM:** To help protect our unique environment along Oak Creek, we have an extended aeration wastewater treatment plant. The heart of this wastewater system depends on "single cell animals." These are very delicate creatures. Poison can kill them. Please come into the Resort with an **EMPTY HOLDING TANK**, and deodorizers must be **FORMALDEHYDE FREE.**
- CIGARETTES:** As with any trash, **DO NOT THROW CIGARETTE BUTTS ON THE GROUND.** There is **ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING ALLOWED IN ANY OF OUR BUILDINGS, FACILITIES, POOL, OFFICE AND STORE AREA.**
- QUIET HOURS:** 10 PM to 9 AM. If you must play a radio at any time, it is too loud if anyone but you can hear it.
- CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT: CABIN CHECK-IN IS AFTER 3:00 PM BUT BEFORE DARK. SITE CHECK-IN IS AFTER 12:00 NOON BUT BEFORE DARK. CABIN AND SITE CHECK-OUT IS 11 AM.**
- There is **NO STOPPING** or parking in front of the office or store at any time.
- If you do not have a tow vehicle and are driving your camping unit out for the day, be sure to put a site occupied sign in your site. Signs are available at the office.
